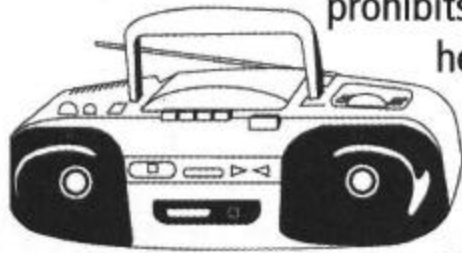


From the Police Department **A Few Friendly Reminders . . .**

Sidewalks and vehicles: Please be considerate of others in your neighborhood and park your vehicle so it does not block the public sidewalk.

Keep the noise down: Village ordinance prohibits noise loud enough to be heard more than 50 feet from the property line where the noise is originating. Not everyone has the same



taste in music -- please respect the rights of your neighbors.

Only licensed and registered vehicles may be driven on public property: No motorized

vehicle (electric or gas) may be driven on any Village street or sidewalk without the proper license and registration.

Mini-bikes, pocket bikes, go carts, etc., are not eligible for registration and therefore cannot be driven on public property.



Overnight parking ban: No vehicle may be parked on any Village street between the hours of 2:00 AM-6:00 AM throughout the year.

Loud noise from vehicles: Village ordinance and state law prohibit noise coming from a vehicle which can be heard from more than 75 feet away.
