THE BASICS OF NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

- Watch groups are **NOT** vigilantes. They are extra eyes and ears for reporting crime & helping neighbors. Neighborhood Watch helps build pride and serves as a spring-board for efforts that address community concerns such as beautification and disaster preparedness.
- Any community resident can join—young or old, single or married, renter or homeowner. There is no cost to join.
- Participants learn how to make their homes more secure, watch out for each other and the neighborhood, and report activities that raise suspicions to the Police Department.
- Volunteer residents organize our Neighborhood Watch (NW). Our neighborhood chair stays in contact with the police and keeps track of neighborhood documents. Each block of approximately 12-15 homes has a captain who distributes information and acts as a point person.
- Our NW stays active by holding periodic meetings, and coordinates the annual beautification day, and also start to have more social events such as cookouts or other fun events.

Things That Should Alert You

- Someone looking into windows and parked cars.
- Unusual noises i.e. screaming or shouting for help
- Property being taken out of closed businesses or houses where no one is at home.
- Cars, vans or trucks moving slowly with no apparent destination, appearing repeatedly, or without lights.
- Anyone being forced into a vehicle.
- A stranger sitting in a car or stopping to talk to a child.

How To Report A Crime

Call the appropriate number, either 9-1-1 for emergencies or 847-551-3481 for non-emergencies.

- Give your name and address. (There is also an anonymous crime tip line, 847-551-3488, if you prefer not to be identified.)
- Briefly describe the event: what happened, when, where & who was involved.
- Describe the suspect's sex, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, & distinctive characteristics, such as a beard, mustache, or scars.
- Describe the vehicle if one was involved: color, make, model, year, license plate, & special features such as stickers, dents or decals.

Village Code Enforcement

Maintaining our properties also keeps our neighborhood safe. Code Enforcement is NOT handled through the police department, but through the Village or our Home Owners Association Property Manager and Board of Directors. Please 1st call our property manager at 847-742-5555. You can all call the village at 847-551-3478 to report any violations. (Anonymous Tip Line, 847-426-9600).

Here are a few of the Village codes relevant to Spring Acres Hills:

- No trailers, boats, etc may be parked on street or in front of property.
- Permits are required for most home improvements or repairs. Also, approval by the Spring Acres Hills Board of Directors may be needed before getting approval from the Village.
- 2 dogs allowed/single family residence.
- No peeling or chipped paint allowed on home exterior.
- No parking on non-paved/graveled surfaces or across sidewalks.
- Weeds and grass must be kept to less than 8 inches high.
- Garage sales limited to 2/year.
- A license is required for rental properties.
- All exterior property must be kept clean, safe, and sanitary with no garbage visible.
- Sidewalks and driveways must be in proper repair.
- House numbers should be easily read from street.
